## Natural Person Residency

1. Submit a clear image of your national ID or passport to [gsp@prospera.hn](mailto:gsp@prospera.hn) soliciting a Natural Person residency.
2. Fill out the [Background Check Consent](#).
3. Digitally sign the [Agreement of Coexistence](#).
4. Receive an invoice in your inbox from the Próspera ZEDE Trust for your residency and follow payment instructions.
5. Determine whether or not you will be operating in a regulated industry and follow the proceeding steps.
6. Fill out the [Hazardous Activity Disclosure](#).

### To Operate in a Non-Regulated Industry:

1. Digitally sign [standardized general liability insurance policy](#).
2. Receive an invoice in your inbox from the Próspera Insurance Company (PIC) and follow payment instructions.
3. Visit the Beta Building Welcome Desk to obtain your residency pass.

## Legal Entity – Limited Liability Company

2. Obtain a Registered Agent from a third party.
3. Digitally sign the [Agreement of Coexistence](#).
4. Receive an invoice via email from the Próspera ZEDE Trust for the entity and follow payment instructions.
5. Determine if the entity will be operating in a regulated industry and specify in the following forms.
6. Fill out the [Hazardous Activity Disclosure](#).
7. Fill out the [Insurance Questionnaire](#).
8. Receive an invoice via email from the Próspera Insurance Company (PIC) and follow payment instructions.
9. Digitally sign the insurance policy received via email.

## E-Residency Entity – Limited Liability Company

1. If you would like to form an E-Residency entity, login to your user on the ePróspera [platform](#) and formalize the entity there.

## Entity Renewal

1. Ensure that taxes are declared and paid.
2. Receive an invoice via email from the Próspera ZEDE Trust for the annual entity fees and follow payment instructions.
3. Receive an invoice via email from the Próspera Insurance Company (PIC) for any renewing policies and follow payment instructions.
4. Renew any Registered Agent agreements.
5. Submit an [Annual Report](#) for the entity.

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# BASIC TAX INFO

## Three Types

North Bay GSP, Inc. (the “General Service Provider”) serves as Tax Commissioner pursuant to the Próspera Tax Statute 2019 and its contract with Próspera for the provision of municipal and other services.

Payments are made to the Próspera Trust.

## Income Tax
